

The Applied Academics for Adult Education (AAAE) Program is for students who already have a high school diploma and are enrolled in a career certificate program but need some assistance obtaining a passing score on the TABE test.

The program offers non-credit courses mathematics, language arts or/and reading courses to prepare students to successfully complete the requirements of their workforce program.

### Important for You to Know

Adult Education courses are hybrid classes made up of a face-to-face class and independent online work. For most classes, the face-to-face class can meet on-campus or online. Please see your program advisor about which option works best for your learning style and schedule.

Placement is based on a student's scores on the TABE test. Students must score above **500** in Reading to qualify for the Adult Education program.

Students who score into NRS 5 or 6 have the option of taking ABX or HSE classes – depending on their personal needs and preference.
