### Important for You to Know

ESOL courses are hybrid classes made up of a face-to-face class and independent online work. For CCR classes, the face-to-face class generally meets online.

The ELCATE program has a minimum of 350 contact hours in addition to the contact hours required for your selected career certificate program. Students with higher CASAS scores may not be required to complete all program contact hours.

ELCATE students must be careful not to test out of the Level 6 range since they lose eligibility for the ELCATE program once they score above 235 in Reading and score above 227 in Listening.

**Note**: Students can bypass the Civics & Law class by earning a passing score on the ESOL Civics Test.
